### **Management Recommendations**

Planting

A fast-emerging hybrid good for cold tough soils. Plant 2.5 to 2.75 inches deep. Ear size does flex. Plant at standard populations but will also do very well at lower populations. Do not plant after May 25th. Works on all soil types and cropping systems. Especially suited for no-till. A good option for corn on corn rotations.

**Early Season**Rapid early season growth. Canopies early. Excellent choice for organic acres and will handle dry periods.
Develops a stong root system.

**Mid-Season** Flowers early to allow for longer grain fill period. Check for leaf disease; spray if showing any leaf disease for top yields.

**Late Season** Taller hybrid. Can set two ears. Very healthy plant. Holds plant health until frost. Best option of the <80 day products for silage.

**Harvest** Stands well. Tall enough to handle early snowfall. Dries down well when matured. Consistent top performer across environments. Dent hybrid.
