#### **Management Recommendations**

**Planting** Do not plant more than 28,000 ppa, especially in 30" rows. Works in all types of tillage systems. Strong in corn

on corn rotations.

Strong emergence and fast early growth. **Early Season** 

Has good disease tolerance, but can consider foliar fungicide application if symptoms appear. Mid-Season

Big. Very dense canopy; minimal light penetration to the soil. Stands well. Late Season

Maintains health for longer chopping window. Thick canopy with good ground shading. High tonnage with Harvest
