Management Recommendations

Planting	Do not plant more than 28,000 ppa, especially in 30" rows. Works in all types of tillage systems. Strong in corn on corn rotations.
Early Season	Strong emergence and fast early growth.
Mid-Season	Has good disease tolerance, but can consider foliar fungicide application if symptoms appear.
Late Season	Big. Very dense canopy; minimal light penetration to the soil. Stands well.
Harvest	Maintains health for longer chopping window. Thick canopy with good ground shading. High tonnage with very good quality.
