### **Management Recommendations**

**Planting** Plant at moderate populations for your area and let the ear flex go to work for you. Emergence and early vigor are good, but plant your other hybrids before Charo. It does not like cold, wet conditions. We've seen Charo

move South into fuller season maturity zones and do extremely well.

**Early Season** The plant grows fast once established. While not needed, Charo responds well to high-management farming

and spoon-feeding nutrients.

**Mid-Season** Leaf disease tolerance is pretty good, with most things being rated good to very good. Although generally not

needed, it has shown a favorable response to fungicide application.

**Late Season** Very good stalk and root ratings, with decent plant health. Does have dual utility for silage use because of

plant size. Other products may have better feed value.

**Harvest** Girthy, flex ear with excellent kernel depth. Very good stalk and root ratings.
