Recommended Uses: Grain, Silage



Management Recommendations

Planting	Plant 2.25" - 3" deep. Can plant early. Not rotation sensitive - corn on corn is fine. Does not move south well - keep in zone.
Early Season	Very fast emergence with early vigor. A lot of plant material quickly.
Mid-Season	Taller hybrid that flowers appropriately for maturity.
Late Season	Generally healthy all season long. Silage harvest is earlier than you may think. Cut some samples to test while husks are green to know whole plant moisture. Silage yields are high with great feed value.
Harvest	Solid dry down for grain harvest.
