Management Recommendations

Planting Plant 2.25" - 3" deep. Can plant early. Not rotation sensitive - corn on corn is fine. Does not move south well -

keep in zone.

Early Season Very fast emergence with early vigor. A lot of plant material quickly.

Mid-Season Taller hybrid that flowers appropriately for maturity.

Generally healthy all season long. Silage harvest is earlier than you may think. Cut some samples to test while **Late Season**

husks are green to know whole plant moisture. Silage yields are high with great feed value.

Solid dry down for grain harvest. Harvest
