



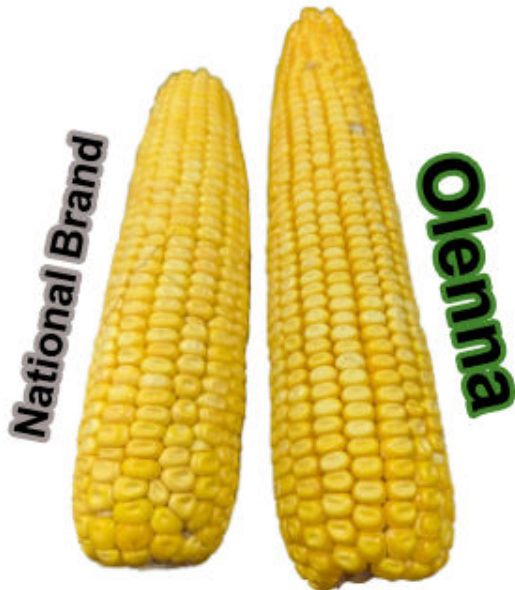

## Management Recommendations

<b>Planting</b>	Plant 2.5" deep. Handles a range of soil types and conditions. Handles some stressier areas. A good choice for hills.
<b>Early Season</b>	Has strong early growth.
<b>Mid-Season</b>	Penetrating root type helps Olenna handle drier conditions.
<b>Late Season</b>	Scout for foliar disease. Olenna sometimes needs a fungicide application.
<b>Harvest</b>	Has a long flex ear.
