Management Recommendations

Planting Plant 2.5-2.75" deep as soon as conditions allow. Very good cold tolerance and emergence. Plant at normal

populations for the area. Excellent for no-till.

Dark green. A shorter plant with very upright leaves--row shading could be an issue in rows wider than 30" or **Early Season**

at very low populations. Handles dry weather well.

Mid-Season Silks and pollinates well under stress. Will respond to side-dressed nitrogen if seasonal weather supports the

application.

Healthy late into the season. Will dry down. Shorter stature. Late Season

Stands and waits for the combine, but must be harvested before a major snow event. Good test weight. Harvest
